



INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE UNREACHED

Supporters of International Day for the Unreached

An alliance of evangelistic ministries is calling on all Christians to participate in the International Day for the Unreached on May 20, 2018, as part of a renewed effort to reach out to the more than 2 billion people around the world who have yet to hear the gospel.

Alliance members include Bibles For the World, Missio Nexus, Operation Mobilization, Reach Beyond, Partners International, World Mission, Mission Network News and ZimZam Global. A description of the ministries follows:

Bibles For The World (www.biblesfortheworld.org) is a catalyst for individual and cultural transformation through Christ and the power of his word. Since 1971, Bibles For The World (BFTW) has made God's word available—free of charge—to millions upon millions of people in more than 115 countries across the globe. BFTW is committed to Christian education and compassionate care, having established a hospital and dozens of elementary and secondary schools plus a college and seminary in NE India and Delhi.

Missio Nexus (www.missionexus.org) is the largest and most inclusive organization of Great Commission-oriented evangelical ministries in North America. It fosters shared learning and opportunities for collaborative action and also produces increased effectiveness through its many mission-oriented products, programs and services. The network is the result of a 2012 merger between two long-standing mission associations, the CrossGlobal Link and The Mission Exchange.

Operation Mobilization's (www.omusa.org) role is to mobilize Christians to share the knowledge of Jesus and his love with every generation in every nation. The group pioneers and leads initiatives to redeem lives, rebuild communities and restore hope in over 110 countries. Operation Mobilization (OM) seeks to help plant and strengthen churches, especially in areas where Christ is least known.

Reach Beyond (www.reachbeyond.org) is a media- and medical-based evangelical outreach ministry with operations on five continents. It spreads the gospel of Jesus through modern media, including radio broadcasts, webcasts, social media and solar-powered radio distribution. It also provides medical services to the needy throughout its network as a way to allow people to feel the touch of the Lord as well as hear his word.

Partners International (www.partnersintl.org) exists to connect the global Christian community to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the least reached, least resourced nations on earth. Their aim is to build the church in the least reached places by partnering with indigenous ministries and connecting followers of Christ through church planting, empowering women, ministering to children and transforming communities. Projects include Bible schools/seminaries, child sponsorship, urban ministries, prison ministries, clean water projects and media ministries, as well as others.

World Mission (www.worldmission.cc) is a Christian non-profit organization focusing on the distribution of *The Treasure* (a solar-powered audio Bible given to oral learners in their own language) throughout the world. They are primarily focused on reaching the people groups that are still considered unreached, where less than 2% of the population identifies as Christians and many are illiterate. They seek to accomplish this goal through a network of prayer support and funding from individuals, organizations, World Mission thrift stores, and recycling projects.

Mission Network News (www.mnnonline.org) has a vision to see the body of Christ engaged to reach people. Their mission is to bring glory to God by telling the stories of His work around the world through His people in a way that activates the body of Christ to pray, give, and go. Mission Network News will continue being the voice of missions, the persecuted Church, and Christians in hard-to-reach areas of the world. Together with strategic partners, they seek to help fulfill the Great Commission in this lifetime.

ZimZam Global (www.zimzamglobal.org) trains leaders to plant churches through discipling children. Believing that children are not just the future of the church but the best hope for its present growth, ZimZam Global's vision is to see a church for every child. Through a concentrated effort on reaching the next generation now, churches have the greatest potential to expedite and fulfill the Great Commission.
